

Cortrosyn or Cortisol Stimulation Test

Most laboratory tests require no special preparation on the part of the patient. There are some, however, that do.

What do I need to know about the Cortrosyn or Cortisol Stimulation Test?

The blood collections are generally performed at the Outpatient Infusion Clinic. You must stay at the collection site for the entire procedure. Your doctor's office must schedule the test through Healthcare Coordination, 494-6900, Option 1.

What do I need to do for the Cortrosyn or Cortisol Stimulation Test?

This test includes three separate blood collections.

- A baseline blood sample will be drawn prior to the injection of Cortrosyn.
- Next the Cortrosyn will be injected.
- A blood sample will be drawn 30 minutes after the injection of Cortrosyn.
- The final blood sample will be drawn one hour after the injection of Cortrosyn.
